





Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us

Hebrews 12:1

There is one week between Christmas Day and New Years Day. I find this week to be a very interesting week. Christmas Day is the culmination of our expectation of the birth of Jesus. We spend the month of December preparing for the life-change that comes with the birth of Jesus. We are expectant for Emmanuel. Then Christmas is over and there is a week lull until the start of a new year. In one week's time, 2020 is behind us, and 2021 starts. We again start getting expectant for what the new year brings. We begin making plans for changes in our lives that we hope and desire for a better year ahead. One week we are making plans for our spiritual life and the birth of Jesus and the next week we are making plans for the rest of our life and the year that is ahead.

I spend a lot of time thinking during that time about how this week could bring both these ideas together. What if instead of simply looking forward to 2021 and the life changes we hope for, we take our excitement about the birth of Christ and cast that forward in 2021. How is your faith going to change the year for you? What new habits do you want to take on to deepen your relationship with God? How do you want to use the time you have to do things that inspire others to faith? Paul writes in Hebrews about taking that which is good and using it while leaving behind that which holds us back. 2020 has been hard. 2021 might be hard. But we know that Jesus is born and we know that our lives are changed because of it.

Use this time to be excited not just about the new year but also the possibilities that God is creating in your life to do good things. God is working in your life. Leave everything else behind and follow God into this coming year.


