



There have been many changes to church over the last several months, including how we are able to meet together. # CALLED BY GOD TO SERVE

Do you desire to respond to God's call on your life?

Lay Servant Ministries is one of the most significant lay leadership development programs already available within the United Methodist connection. This system of training courses is focused on equipping and empowering laypersons who have responded to the call of God to serve in mission and ministry.



These laypersons are called to live out their own discipleship as servants in leadership through ministries of leading, caring and communicating. The United Methodist Church has established three categories for laypersons in the area of servant ministries to develop, prepare and engage Christian leaders.

#### They are:

<u>Certified Lay Servant</u> – serves the local church and beyond by leading prayer, trainings, study and discussion. Assists in services of worship, preaches the Word, fosters caring ministries and more.

<u>Certified Lay Speaker</u> – serves by preaching the Word when requested by the pastor, or district superintendent. This is a specific call for the ministry of pulpit supply.

<u>Certified Lay Minister</u> – serves with a mentor and the supervision of their district superintendent. Conducts public worship, cares for the congregation, develops new faith communities, preaches the Word, leads small groups, assists in program leadership and more.

If you are interested in learning more about the resources designed to equip laity for these roles in ministry as disciples of Jesus Christ, you can find brochures and more information in the "Resource Center" in the church office at St. Luke's UMC. 
