I recently read that the New England colonists were accustomed to regularly celebrating "thanksgivings," or days of prayer thanking God for blessings such as a military victory or the end of a drought. The event that Americans commonly call the "First Thanksgiving" was celebrated by the Pilgrims after their first harvest in the New World in October 1621. This feast lasted three days and was attended by 90 Native Americans from the Wampanoag Tribe and 53 Pilgrims.

I once read the comment, "But shouldn't every day be a day of thanksgiving?" Of course, the answer is "yes," even when our attitudes are screaming at our psyche to complain and be angry. The Bible does not indulge the idea, however, that followers of God should see themselves as victims, even when terrible suffering occurs. First Chronicles reads, "Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever." Indeed, our holy scripture is filled with commands to give thanks to God. Many passages give reasons why we should thank Him, such as "His love endures forever" (Psalm 136:3), "He is good" (Psalm 118:29), and "His mercy is everlasting" (Psalm 100:5). We find that we give thanks, not necessarily because our life circumstances are going well, but because when we are in the presence of God, it is well with our soul regardless of struggles.

1 Thessalonians reads "In everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." This scripture reminds us how gratitude helps us to keep bitterness at bay. We realize that we can have thankful hearts toward God even when we do not feel thankful for the circumstance. "We can grieve and still be thankful. We can hurt and still be thankful. We can be angry at sin and still be thankful toward God. Giving thanks to God keeps our hearts in right relationship with Him and saves us from a host of harmful emotions and attitudes that will rob us of the peace God wants us to experience." When we learn to be thankful "in everything," then every day becomes Thanksgiving Day! This is my prayer and hope for us all at St. Luke's, that the hope of Christ shines forth through our attitude of gratitude!




