FROM THE PASTOR

Finding Yourself in the Frenzy

By the time this article reaches your home, you will probably be exhausted or overwhelmed. Where is Christmas in the midst of too many obligations, family and friend drama, church events, decorations, and impending bills?

It seems with every year, the intensity of the Christmas season and the New Year increases. Simultaneously, our yearning for simplicity, peace, acceptance, wonder and sustaining faith ALSO increases. The problem for most of us this time of year is the almost irresistible vortex of worry and concern that obscures the light of Christ. The son is eclipsed by other issues.

As I pondered this reality during a sleepless night, fighting off my own panic attack, I snapped into the realization that my obstacles and fear give me a direct line to understanding the first Christmas.

Joseph and Mary were forced to travel 80 miles when she was about 9 months pregnant. Their journey would culminate in a crowded city. They had no money and no help. She gave birth in squalor conditions and we have no information that assures us that they were given a room upgrade after the birth. The world around them, save the characters in the birth narrative, was unaware of this momentous arrival of the Messiah. Most of the people crowding into Bethlehem were likely consumed with their own troubles and political worries about the Roman Empire.

No, the tinsel, the warm lights, the parties, the family time, the Facebook posts of family gatherings, and the many opportunities to worship were not available to the Holy Family. They had to bear up under the scrutiny of an unusual birth in an unwelcoming environment, under the religious rule of one who sought to kill this infant threat to his kingship.

When Bethlehem was finally in the rear view mirror, the tiny family fled to a foreign country to live as immigrants. We can assume that was a meager existence with no visits from grandparents, no baby showers, no friends to connect with, and no crystal ball to tell Mary and Joseph what each day would bring.

Two weeks ago, I saw the musical, THE MUSIC MAN. The production's most iconic song is "Trouble in River City." The musical group chants, "yes there's trouble, trouble, trouble, trouble...." The trouble Mary, Joseph and Jesus faced was real, threatening and all encompassing.

What is my point?

Christmas time, from the beginning, has never been easy. The fantastic news is that God delivers his greatest gift of salvation precisely because of our human struggle. As you look at the residual mess from Christmas and prepare to move on to another point in the year, don't return or forget the true gift of the One who comes to us, especially when life is difficult.

The missions team has been working hard to come back to full working capacity following Covid. We have resumed regular meetings and have taken steps to add new projects in 2023. We wanted to take a moment to highlight one of our favorite mission programs.

Backpack Ministry

We are currently providing weekend meal kits for 52 children at Kilgore Primary, Chandler Elementary, and Kilgore Intermediate Schools. Each month volunteers sort the food that is delivered from the East Texas Foodbank and each week volunteers deliver it to the schools. Thanks to grants and your contributions we were able to provide over 1,300 meals last school year. The 2022-2023 saw a rise in students needing assistance. This year we are on track to give out almost 2,000 meals. This ministry will cost us almost \$10,000. Your contributions along with community grants and endowments makes this program possible. Thank you to everyone that contributes to the Backpack Ministry.
